



USEFUL INFORMATION AND TIPS

TICKETS

Access to the Wimbledon Club is by Mobile ticketing via the official Wimbledon 2025 App and you will need to have a *myWimbledon* account. You will also need photo ID



OPENING & MATCHES

The grounds open at 10am. Play on Centre Court is scheduled to start at 1.30pm and No1 Court at 1pm except the Finals weekend [Saturday 12th & Sunday 13th July] when play starts at 1.00pm. [Ladies' and gentlemen's doubles matches commencing at 1pm, prior to the singles finals at 4pm.] Your tickets also allow you access to the outside courts. Matches on all other courts start at 11.00am. Please check the order of play.

FACILITIES

We recommend that you go to the reception area where you will be provided with all the information you may need during your visit. It is important to note that Wimbledon is now a cash-less event.

Centre Court & No. 1 Court Debenture Ticket Holders have their own restaurant and bar facilities which have been designed to be places in which to eat, drink and relax in stylish surroundings.

Generally, light refreshments are available in the restaurants from 10.30am and lunch from 11.00am. Early arrivals can purchase light refreshments at The Terrace, and The Gallery (CC) or The Lounge & No.1 Bar (No.1 C) from 10.00am.

Smoking is not permitted in any of the debenture holders' areas including outdoor balconies

ACCESS TO GROUNDS

Debenture Ticket Holders are encouraged to use Gate 4 [located on Church Road] as this entrance is the closest to the Centre Court and No. 1 Court debenture lounges.

Guests will be asked to show their ticket for scanning at the entry points to the debenture areas upon arrival, where they will be handed a wristband. There will be spot checks conducted during your visit.

The Debenture Arrival Hub is located close to Gate 4 and is a good rendezvous to meet your guests prior to entrance.

RAIN OR SHINE?

The retractable roofs on both Centre & No1 Courts ensures that there will be play as scheduled.

DRESS CODE

Dress code for admittance to the Debenture facilities is smart-casual.

Gentlemen are not required to wear a jacket/tie. Tailored shorts for both ladies and gentlemen are acceptable. Smart trainers are permitted. It is best to prepare for mixed conditions. Even on warm days it may be cooler in the shaded areas so an extra layer of clothing is recommended.

Be prepared with your sun hat and sun cream.

PARKING

Use Car Park 6, which is close to the Debenture Entrance at Gate 4. Contact the AA as you need to make a reservation in advance using the following link: <https://www.theaa.com/wimbledon-parking/> or call The AA on their ticket line 0330 041 3677.

Important:

Drop off for Taxi's, Private Hire, Chauffeurs and Drivers is at the Entrance to Car Park 5. A Temporary Access Pass (TAP) **is required**.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Underground [District Line] – the nearest underground stations are Southfields [approx. 10min walk] and Wimbledon [approx. 20 min walk]. There are shuttle buses from Wimbledon station that run to the Championships every few minutes. There are also plenty of taxis available. South West Trains – An overground rail service to Wimbledon Station from London Waterloo.
